

**TOWN OF OSLER
BYLAW 2016-09
A BYLAW TO REQUIRE CRIMINAL RECORD CHECKS WITH
ELECTION NOMINATION FORMS**

The Council of the Town of Osler, in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

PART I - TITLE

1. This Bylaw may be cited as the "Election Form Criminal Record Check"

PART II – GENERAL

2. Every candidate for the municipal office shall obtain a current (not more than 30 days) Criminal Record Check at their own expense
3. For B.1 (Results of Criminal Record Check for Candidate for Election) of The Municipalities Regulations, must be included with and form part of the completed Nomination Form submitted by the candidate for municipal office.

PART III - COMING INTO FORCE AND EFFECT

4. This bylaw shall come into force upon approval from Council
